My interest was peaked but I didn't think too much about it. One of the sisters turned to me and said "do you have any special occasions coming up? I'm sure Father wouldn't mind signing a book for you!" I then found out he was Fr. Brian Kolodieichuk who is the priest that authored the book for Mother Teresa's 'Come be my Light'. He is also the postulator of the Cause of Beatification and Canonization of Mother Teresa. I said "Yes, my husband's birthday!" Fr. Brian quickly and graciously obliged and wrote a beautiful blessing for my husband in my newly purchased book. I was so thankful that God reached in and helped find a 'special' gift for my husband, especially through the hands of a priest that knew and worked with Mother Teresa.

The second came shortly after this experience and it was when she came to me through a dream. It was such a vivid dream that I can remember most of the details, what she said to me, what she looked like, and how I felt. I came to her crying and very upset, she had a glow around her and she placed her hand on my face. She said "my child, do not worry" (she said a few more things to me which at the time didn't make sense, but now do, but that's too long of a story!) Then she pointed me to Jesus in the Eucharist, where at the time I could feel His Holy Presence. AWE!

These two moments are treasures to me, as are all of you and as this Whispering Winds camp is! I look forward to being on the mountain with you and know that even if you are not able to make it, I personally will be praying for you!




